

The Q Fund 2006 Accomplishments

- Q Fund raised donations by 300%
- Chimoza Community School was one of only 4 community schools in Zambia to be given new textbooks; we now have books for grades 1 through 7, they are beautiful!
- Invited to lecture at the Deepak Chopra Center, Carlsbad, CA July, 06
- Nine volunteers traveled to Zambia to be teachers aids and renovate; paint three buildings at Chimoza Community School in Ndola
- Created a DVD for Q Fund to be used as a fund raising tool, as well a thank you to individuals, corporations and Foundations.
- Built a cottage in the outskirts of Ndola for visiting teachers, nurses and students traveling to volunteer at Chimoza and or “Seeds of Hope”, this organization teaches hygiene to our community and school.
- The work of the Q Fund was featured in an article, in-Flight magazine, Intra-Air, RSA.
- Q Fund added a block of flush toilets at Chimoza
- Built additional classrooms
- Purchased 80 2 seated desks
- Funded a bore-hole in Malawi helping bring fresh water to 10000 students
- Q Fund funded the construction for the Ngererit School in Kenya which educates upwards of 2000 students. I personally visited this wonderful school in Nov. with 3 other potential donors.
- Hope Builders received another \$1000.00 for a water project in Mozambique helping thousands of children and the elderly.
- We are currently working on a one million budget to build a agriculture school in Ndola.
- Continuing our important work with the sustainable banana farm in Zambia with the vision to expand into Kenya, we will also introduce tea with artemisia as a daily beverage to slow the progression from HIV to full blown AIDS. The Artemisia plant is also known to accelerate the healing process of malaria; we are investigating the cost to export into the United States and Europe.
