SUMMARY

Please describe the following:

(a) your key activities:

We hold Board meetings about 4 times per year. We support a variety of projects based on proposals received, but our principle grants have been to Mithra Foundation and several ICDP projects in Colombia and other South American countries.

(b) fundraising efforts:

We applied to the Diana Memorial Fund on behalf of Clearpath International, but our application was unsuccessful. However, we made a grant to Clearpath and pledged another amount for 2007.

We ran a jewellery and bric-a-brac stall at our National Congress and raised c.£600.

We ran a jewellery stall at a summer fair in Sussex and raised c.£160.

We published two newsletters during 2006 which were circulated to all groups in

Britain. In future, we hope to have a regular entry in the Subud Britain Journal, which is bi-monthly.

(d) visits to projects:

Sachlan North attended the Bangalore meeting and visited Mithra, CCD and SRADHA.

Lailah Armstrong is in close contact with ICDP projects in South America and visits Colombia on a regular basis, and reports to SD(B).
