SUMMARY OF ACTIVITIES 2006

- Active partnership with about 20 projects in Indonesia, India, Ecuador, Columbia, Argentina, Paraguay, Brazil, Congo, Ukraine and Germany.
- In the area of Public Relations and Advocacy we held a very successful 4 day seminar in November which was open to the general public. Workshops were held on the principles of Susila Dharma, on the key to becoming motivated and effective and on how to succeed in sponsoring. We were able to get external funding for the seminar so that it didn't burden our budget.
- In the field of publications we produced a new edition of our brochure "Durch Partnerschaft wachsen" (Growth through Partnership), 2 issues of our magazine Umschau (Outlook), 3 issues of our newsletter Einblick (Insight) and weekly issues of our brief office newsletter Susi-Woche (Susi-Week) which keeps our extended team informed about what is going on.
