- (a) **your key activities:** To support SD Projects around the world. By now we are supporting projects in Latin America, Indonesia and India (Mithra project).
- (b) **fundraising efforts:** One of our main sponsors is "Costa Cultural" a cultural association (non Subud) situated in Alfaz del Pi (Alicante-Spain) which mainly supports Mithra Foundation and Colegio Amor through cultural gatherings, concerts, art exhibitions and recitals. Spanish Subud members support specific projects by means of private donations and also through raffles and artistic donations during our gatherings. There is a private initiative from two members who are studying the possibility to create in Alicante a weekly market to sell handicrafts. They are also trying that the local authorities (City Council) sponsors the project.

- (d) **Visits to Projects:** Our treasure, Luz Fockedey will visit Mithra Foundation next August.
- (e) **links to other organizations, agencies, etc.:** "Costa Cultural" (See fundraising efforts). "Lanas sin Fronteras" Association: together with this association we have collected toys

for children in Bucharest (Romania) and also wool to make warm sweaters for people and children of North Europe.

With Oxfam we have arranged a “Just Trade” market selling handicrafts from Burkina Fasso country, getting 136 hours of a worth salary for that artisans.

In collaboration with the UNESCO CLUB of the French School in Alicante, we have sold calendars to buy school materials for schools in Tessa, Manmandeye and Alassandeye villages (Nigeria).

We have actively participated with “Alendainventa” NGO selling postcards during the Christmas campaign to help them to build a nursery school for children in El Mani, Bani, (Dominican Rep.) We got 824 Euros. (Not include in the Financial Report due that it was a private initiative from some members in Alicante).

We have not taken any step yet to get a link at governmental level.

2005 ACCOMPLISHMENTS AND HIGHLIGHTS

Describe your accomplishments and highlights (notable development, milestones met, special activities, etc.) for the past year:

Due to the Tsunami disaster in Asia, during 2005 our main purpose was to help that countries by different ways. Some Subud members decided to send money directly to Red Cross and others NGO’s, and some others via SDI to help Subud Indonesia project in Aceh. For that reason we could not support Mithra Foundation this time.

During our National Congress hold last December we had collected about 1023 \$US to support “Fundación Despertar” in Mina Clavero (Argentina) and also the project “Cod-Liver Oil Omega 3” for children in Chile.
