

TEACHERS AND VOLUNTEERS NEEDED AT BINA CITA UTAMA SCHOOL - KALIMANTAN

The school, consisting of a primary school with grades 1 - 6, and a high school with students in grade 8, 9 and 10, is slowly but surely growing. It has now received full accreditation from the Indonesian government, as an English-speaking National Plus school. We currently have 7 full time teachers, another 7 part-timers and support staff, and 33 students.

As the school is gaining popularity in the region, it is likely that student numbers will rise at the start of the academic year 2007-2008, in July. However, sadly, quite a few of the current (volunteer) teaching staff plan to leave BCU in June. This means a range of positions will become open for new applicants.

"Working at BCU is an incredible experience for me. While certainly challenging at times, it is rewarding and very interesting to be a member of the team that is building the foundations of this school. Slowly I am gaining an understanding of the enormous potential this school/community could have. And apart from all this, simply the experience of living in Kalimantan, is bringing me a vast amount of blessings."

Experience of teaching is desirable, but, especially in the case of volunteering, not essential. We are looking for native or fluent speakers of English, who enjoy working with children (obviously!) and feel inspired to live in this community and contribute to the development and learning of our students.
